TEEP also allows international students to gain an in-depth educational experience in Taiwan, while also preparing themselves for the Asian job market.

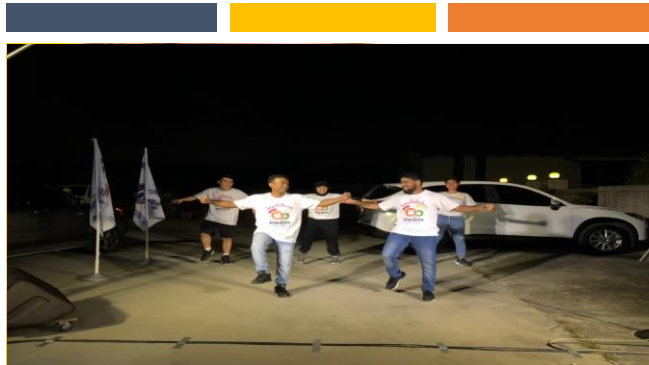

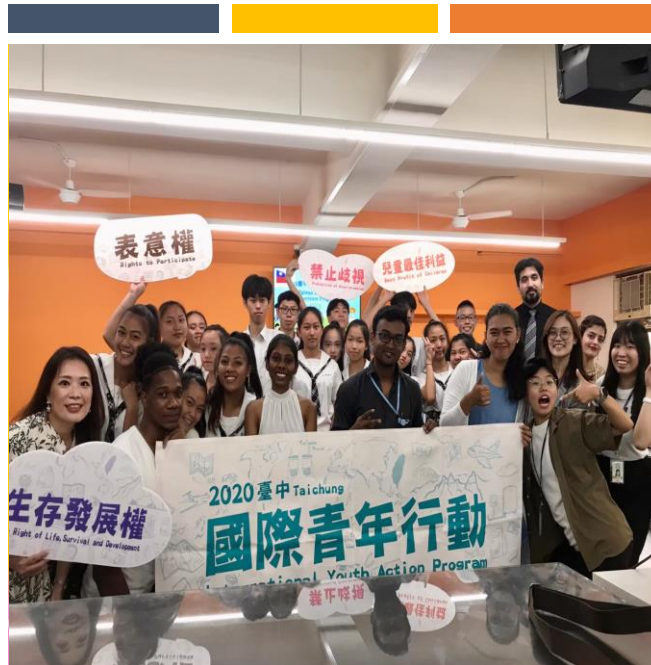

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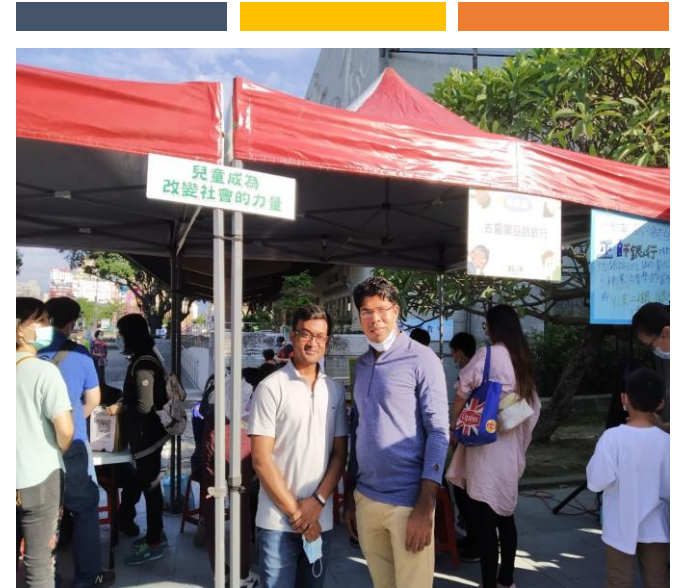




Children's Garden Party

We were assigned to teach English to the young children in Dingtai community. We would show them the photos and word and they'd write it in their paper.

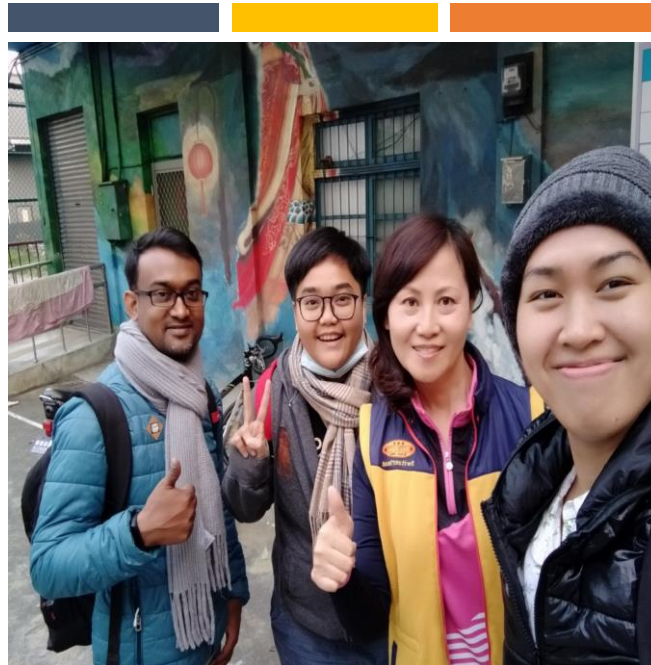




Dingtai Community Christmas Party 2020

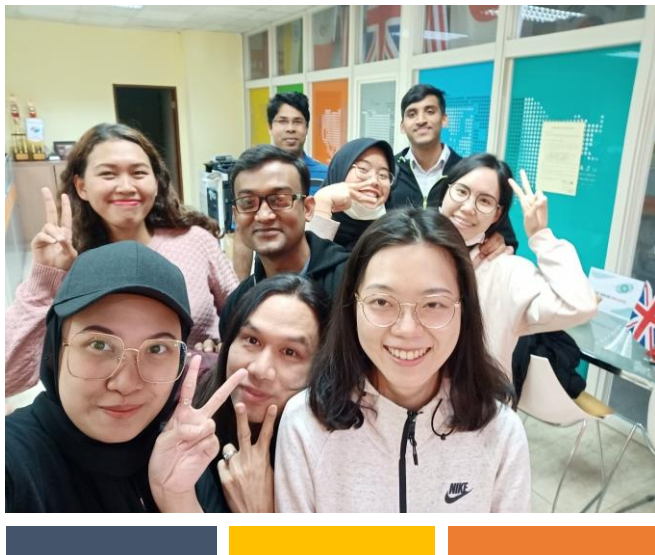


Elementary Students are talking about Indian greetings and some basic culture
