## 3 key points for riding an E-bike

- Wearing a helmet is required for riding, and the violators will be fined \$300 NTO.
- Modifying is not allowed, and the violators will be fined \$5,400 NTO the most.
- Carrying people is not allowed, and the violators will be fined more than \$300 NTO.

## PRECAUTIONS FOR ELECTRIC BICYCLE

## IT IS ILLEGAL TO MODIFY AN ELECTRIC BICYCLE WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION!

1

Unauthorized changes to the original specifications of other safety equipment. Violators will be fined NTD\$ 5,400 and must revert to the original specifications.

2

The maximum speed of electric bicycles is 25km/h. If you exceed the speed limit, you will be fined NTD\$1,800 at the highest point.

Riding an electric bicycle requires wearing a helmet, and offenders will be fined NTD\$300.

Electric bicycles are not allowed to carry people, and offenders will be fined up to NTD\$600.

Drivers of electric bicycles breathe breathalyzer exceeds 0.5 mg/L or blood alcohol concentration exceeds 0.03% shall be fined NTD\$600-1.200.
