ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Hosted by the College of Creative Design at Asia University, Taiwan, the Creative and Cultural Aesthetics 2025 Summer Program offers a 9-day immersive learning experience that explores the dynamic intersection of design thinking, cultural identity, and creative innovation.

Guided by renowned faculty across multiple design disciplines, students will engage deeply with Taiwan's cultural and creative landscape through a curriculum that integrates traditional craft techniques, product design, visual communication, and animation character creation.

Our summer program: Language and Culture (54 hours in total) is designed to meet the needs of those who want to explore the richness and diversity of Taiwanese community and culture in combination with the acquisition of Mandarin Chinese, one of the world's major languages. The course covers a wide range of language and cultural topics, such as Chinese for daily usage and travelling, Taiwanese food culture, folk life, festivals, etc. Three academic credits will be awarded by the University after the completion of the program. Students are expected to develop their cross-culture awareness and expand their international networking as well as their global perspectives.
